- The LearnAble Project



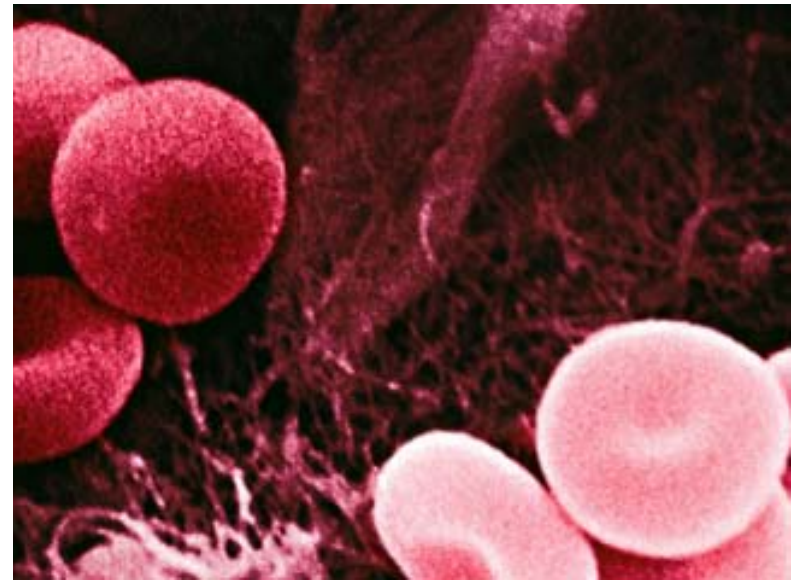
Research at the Academy nov 07

- Biomaterials

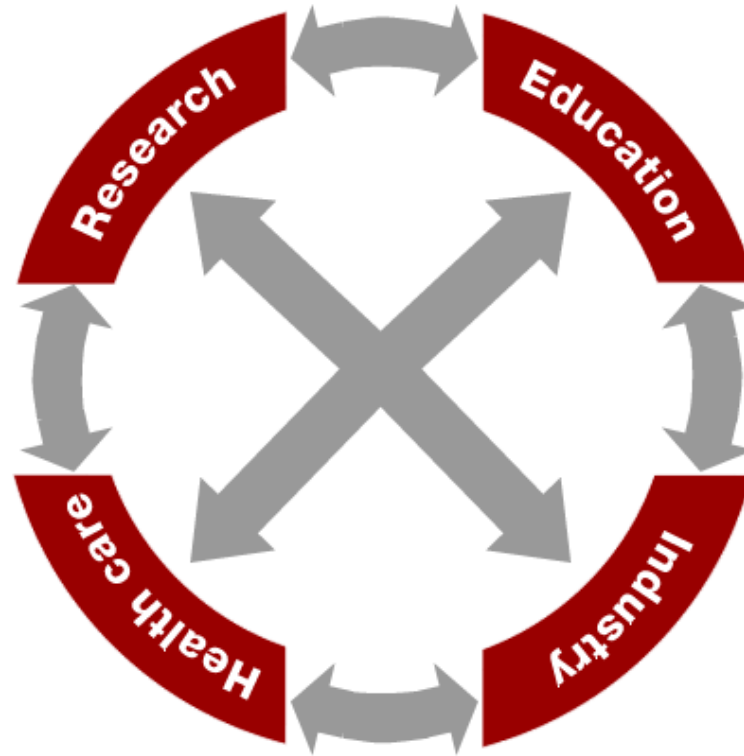
